Duties and Responsibilities

- Collect tickets at the door
- Hand out film ballots at the door
- Greet patrons
- Assist patrons with seating and make sure reserved seats are held for the intended people
- Handle microphones on both sides of the theater during any post-film Q&A
- Collect film ballots from patrons as they exit the theater

If selected, you will be asked to attend one of two training sessions in the weeks precluding the festival. Attendance is mandatory. Volunteers also get free admission to all films! Must be able to get to all venues.
